



Sharing with your team

There are various document sharing and project management tools to cooperate and help discussions run smoothly.

Project management tools include software for creating dashboards to give a better vision of work flows, as well as instant messaging services to facilitate communication.

Among the best-known tools are :

- **KanDo**, proposed by Université Rennes 2's services. The platform has a [kanban board structure](#).
- **Mattermost**, one of the services provided by [Huma-Num](#) and thus accessible from your [HumanID](#) account. This is an open-source chat service that can also be used to share files and may be integrated with existing tools.

For online file sharing, in addition to well-known services such as Dropbox and Google Drive, Docs, and Sheets, which pose ethical and security problems, Huma-Num proposes an alternative : **ShareDocs**, accessible via your [HumanID](#) account. In addition to providing file storage and sharing, ShareDocs has [processing tools](#) such as conversion tools, audio and video transcoding, and optical character recognition (**OCR**).

For software development and website generation, Huma-Num has a version of the **GitLab** platform. This software may be used to share source code, manage deposits and versions, and provide continuous integration and ticket management, with a card corresponding to a task and a column to state of progress. Columns may be subdivided to indicate working groups and thus clearly allocate tasks to different people.
